## ~LVDC 2015 Tags~

---

- Tags are a great and fun way to get to know other LVDC members, play courses you may not usually play, as well as, foster friendship and competition within the organization.
- Tags are created and distributed by the Lehigh Valley Disc Club (LVDC). The cost is \$15. Funds will benefit the organization. By purchasing a tag and signing the member agreement, the buyer becomes a club member.
- A member may only possess 1 tag. If a tag is lost, a replacement may be purchased for \$20, if tags are still available. You will receive the next numbered tag to be purchased. If the original tag is found, one of the two tags must be returned to the LVDC, replacement cost will be refunded.
- Tags are sold year round. They are redistributed annually at the LVDC Ice Bowl held at South Mountain in late January/early February.
- There are many ways to play/defend your tag. The simplest is by playing a round with other tag holders. At the beginning of the round, each player must present their numbered tag. After the round is complete, the tags are redistributed with the lowest score receiving the lowest numbered tag and the highest score receiving the highest numbered tag.
- Tag rounds are held every Sunday at 11 AM, on a rotating schedule, it is free to play. Courses played are South Mountain, Jordan Creek, and Wehr's Dam. Potentially, adding new courses throughout the year. An optional \$1 may be collected for the Ace pot.
- You can play for tags anytime, at any course, with at least 2 tag holders competing.
- Singles tournaments are another way to play for tags. At the beginning of a tournament, a designated member of the LVDC will collect your tag and mark down what number you have. At the tournament's conclusion, tags are distributed by score.
- In the event of a tie, the person with the lower tag at the beginning of the round receives the lower tag from the tie.
- Tags are meant as a way to introduce friendly competition between LVDC members. There is no prize for having the lowest tag. As such, it is encouraged that members do not hold onto their tag in fear of losing it. Everyone goes up and down in number throughout the year. It's all part of the fun!
